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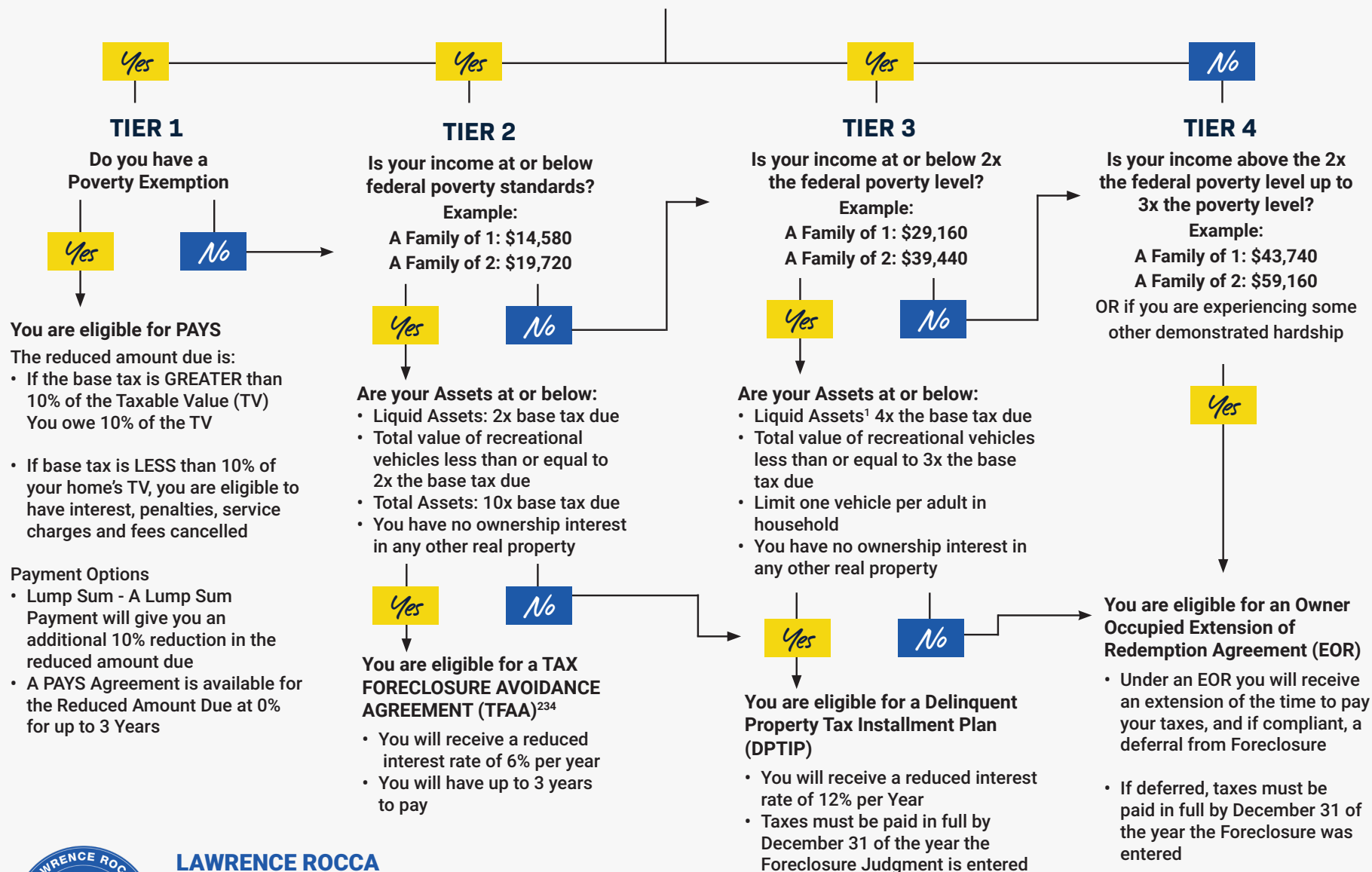

Guide to hardship extensions for delinquent property taxes

Do you own and occupy your property as your primary residence? †

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1. Liquid Assets include, but are not limited to bank accounts, stocks, bonds, investments, pensions, etc.

2. Must keep non delinquent taxes current

3. By Law you are limited to 2 such agreements

4. Delinquencies in any extension plan may make you ineligible

* Program guidelines and a homeowner's eligibility for any program is within the Treasurer's sole discretion

† In order to qualify as primary residence you must receive a PRE.

Income thresholds are based on the federal poverty level which changes annually.
